Subject	Expectation	Information for this week
Reading	2x RWI books sent home each week to be read daily.	Children should read their RWI reading books daily throughout the week. Reading a book more than once helps children to build fluency and comprehension skills. Before reading the book, children should practice their sounds, green words and red words at the front of the book. Please write in the reading diary the date and any comments about your children's reading.
Phonics and Spellings	1x RWI virtual sound video sent home each week. 1x spelling / sound focus sheet each week. 1x RWI virtual spelling video to support.	Children should watch the virtual classroom video each week to consolidate their sound knowledge and learning from in class that week. Children will have one spelling sheet / sound practice sheet sent home each week. These are assigned to support children to practice their sound knowledge from in class that week or revisit previous sounds.
Maths	1x online activity or 1x activity sheet each week.	This activity will be chosen to reinforce learning from in class that week. This may be an activity sheet or on an online platform such as numbots.
Foundation Subjects: Science, Art, Humanities, RE	Activities will be sent home at different times throughout the year to support children's learning in class.	These activities may take longer to complete. They will practice skills or deepen understanding of what your child is learning in class. When the children begin a new learning sequence in History or Geography they will be sent home with a homework menu linked to their class focus. This will be a mixture of written or practical tasks to explore as a family. Children can choose which tasks interest them to have a go at completing.
