Subject	Expectation	Information
Reading	20 mins at least 3x a week	<p>Reading your school reading book and then any other text you would like to read or share with an adult at home.</p> <p>Please write in your reading diary the date, what has been read and to what page so this can be followed on at school.</p> <p>We are still working through our own reading assessments so your child's book band may change quickly, including moving onto Accelerated Reader (AR)</p> <p>Our next guided reading text is allocated to your child through maths flex.</p>
Writing (phonics/spellings)	X1 weekly piece	<p>What is your favourite fairy tale?</p> <p>Write your own version for us to share and celebrate.</p>
Maths (Times Tables) Length and Perimeter	X1 weekly piece	<p>Maths Flex</p> <p>Practice times tables on ttrackstars.</p> <p>It is important that children have a fast recall of their times tables so not only will they be ready for their national times table check in Year 4 but they can use this to support their learning of new maths concepts. Please start on the 2x table.</p>
Foundation Subjects (Science, Arts, Humanities, RE)	Please refer to the foundation subject's homework menu. These activities may take longer to complete and will support your child's topic over a number of weeks. They will practice skills or deepen understanding of what your child is learning in school.
