Reading	RWI books are changed every 3 days now!	The children have been sent home with 2 Read Write Inc books. Children should read their RWI books daily throughout the week. Reading a book more than once helps children to build fluency and comprehension skills. Before reading the book children should practice their sounds, green words, and red words. Please write in their reading diary the date and any comments about your child's reading.

Maths	Maths jam Numbots Children have been sent home with a times tables sheet – focusing on the 2 and 5 times table.	This week we have been finishing our unit on 2D and 3D shapes. I have assigned some maths activities for the children that links to the work that we have been following in class. The children are getting really good at recognising the different shapes in their work. They also have numbots –Children's logins are on their yellow reading books.
Foundation Subjects: Science, Art, Humanities, RE	Activities will be sent home at different times throughout the year to support children's learning in class.	There is a foundation subject homework also put out on Class Dojo containing different options of homework linking to their other subjects. It contains information for geography, science, RE and PSHE.
