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| Geography Topic: The United Kingdom | Have a walk through your local area. What do you notice that are human features? What physical features can you find? |
| | Human and physical features are things that you can see all around you. |
| | Physical features like seas, mountains and rivers are natural . They would be here even if there were no people around. Human features are things like houses, roads and bridges. They have been built by people . |
| | Use maps (physical ones or online maps with a grown up) to locate some rivers, lakes, seas and oceans in and around the UK. |
| | Use a compass (most mobile phones have these if you don't have one) to locate North, South, East and West. Can you guide a grown up from one point in your house to another? E.g. Two steps North, Three steps to the West. |
| Science Topic: Rocks | Look around your home. Think about the properties that different materials have and why this is useful. E.g. A sponge is absorbent to clear up water. Some properties you could think about are: strength, hardness, softness, absorbency, transparency or opaqueness, retain heat. |
| PSHE Topic: Being Me | What makes you proud to be you? What things have you accomplished? |
| Music Topic: Writing Music Down | At home, listen to some different music styles with a grown up (classical, pop, gospel, jazz, ballad). What do you like about the music? What don't you like about the music? |
| | While listening, tap the pulse of the music and try to stay in time. Can you notice when the pitch is high or low? Was the note long or short? |
