Task	Information
Geography Topic: The United Kingdom	<p>Have a walk through your local area. What do you notice that are human features? What physical features can you find?</p> <p>Human and physical features are things that you can see all around you.</p> <p>Physical features like seas, mountains and rivers are natural. They would be here even if there were no people around. Human features are things like houses, roads and bridges. They have been built by people.</p>
	<p>Use maps (physical ones or online maps with a grown up) to locate some rivers, lakes, seas and oceans in and around the UK.</p>
	<p>Use a compass (most mobile phones have these if you don't have one) to locate North, South, East and West. Can you guide a grown up from one point in your house to another? E.g. Two steps North, Three steps to the West.</p>
Science Topic: Rocks	<p>Look around your home. Think about the properties that different materials have and why this is useful. E.g. A sponge is absorbent to clear up water. Some properties you could think about are: strength, hardness, softness, absorbency, transparency or opaqueness, retain heat.</p>
PSHE Topic: Being Me	<p>What makes you proud to be you? What things have you accomplished?</p>
Music Topic: Writing Music Down	<p>At home, listen to some different music styles with a grown up (classical, pop, gospel, jazz, ballad). What do you like about the music? What don't you like about the music?</p> <p>While listening, tap the pulse of the music and try to stay in time.</p> <p>Can you notice when the pitch is high or low? Was the note long or short?</p>
